## Code of Conduct

It is a condition of entry to the 2009 PA National Junior Camp [the Camp] that you agree to abide by the following Code of Conduct:

- Abide by the rules of the target pistol shooting sport and in particular those that relate to safety.
- Follow the directions given by Camp officials at all times.
- Respect the rights of others at all times.
- Take responsibility for your actions on and off the range.
- Comply with the program schedule as requested by Camp officials.
- Remain in the Camp complex unless with the knowledge and prior approval of a Camp official.
- Undertake not to share accommodation with the opposite gender.
- Maintain personal accommodation space in a clean and tidy manner at all times.
- Commit 100% effort to all training activities for maximum personal improvement.

Designated officials are authorised to require you to leave the Camp if you breach the Code by:

- Drinking alcohol on the premises or using illicit substances.
- Engaging in verbal or physical abuse of another person.
- Harassment of individuals and/or of any group.
- Questioning decision(s) of Camp official(s).
- Ridicule, baiting or uttering obscenities.
- Engaging in behaviour that is not respectful to others.

If the Code is breached and/or a person is asked to leave the Camp further action may be taken if deemed necessary.

One of the aims of the 2009 PA National Junior Camp is that it is conducted in an enjoyable and supportive environment. Your compliance with the above Code of Conduct will help to ensure that all participants find their sporting experience both positive and fulfilling.
