



# PISTOL AUSTRALIA INC.

## CHARTER FOR THE NATIONAL COACHING COUNCIL

It is the purpose of this Charter to provide Pistol Australia (PA) with the rules governing the formation and management of a standing sub-committee within the structure of PA.

- 1. Name:** The National Coaching Council (NCC).
- 2. Objective:** To develop qualified coaches in the sport of target pistol shooting.
- 3. Council:** The National Coaching Council shall be representative of all PA affiliates. These representatives shall be:
  - a.** State/Territory Coaching Directors;
  - b.** National Training Squad Management representative;
  - c.** Member of PA Management (ex officio)
  - d.** National Coaching Council Director

The National Coaching Council Director shall chair the Council and be responsible for implementing all Policy.

The Council shall meet at least once a year.

- 4. Finance:** To be provided by:
  - i.** PA
  - ii.** Other sources

### REGULATIONS

- 1. Aim:** To achieve the objectives set out in the NCC Charter by:
  - 1.01** Increasing the number of accredited PA coaches at all levels;
  - 1.02** Developing and implementing a curriculum approved by the Australian Coaching Council, for the training and accreditation of coaches;
  - 1.03** Monitoring the activities and assessing the capabilities of all accredited coaches, particularly level 2 and 3 accredited coaches;

- 1.04 Planning and developing changes to the approved curriculum to cater for changes in technology, shooting techniques and other related matters;
- 1.05 Conducting seminars and other activities related to the coaching of target pistol shooting.

## 2. Management:

The Director shall be responsible for:

- 2.01 The overall management of the NCC;
- 2.02 Ensuring the training and accreditation standards for coaches required by the Australian Coaching Council are met;
- 2.03 Maintaining an up-to-date Register of all NCC and Australian Coaching Council accredited coaches;
- 2.04 Ensuring the proper conduct of NCC sponsored activities;
- 2.05 The development and conduct of examinations for coaching and accreditation;
- 2.06 The development of a program to ensure all accredited coaches are kept aware of and conversant with new and changing coaching methods;
- 2.07 The co-ordination and development of recommendations on grading levels, shooting standards and associated matters for submission to PA Management;
- 2.08 The development of assessments/recommendations for notification of changes in accreditation;
- 2.09 Submitting timely reports on NCC activities to PA Management, State Secretaries, NCC members and the *Australian Pistol Shooters Bulletin*;
- 2.10 Submitting within 30 days of any NCC activity that involved expenditure in excess of \$100.00, a detailed report on the prescribed form, to PA Management;
- 2.11 The development of a budget for the NCC for timely submission to PA Management;
- 2.12 Report to PA Management on performance against budget as and when required;
- 2.13 Report on the activities of all Level 2 & 3 coaches to PA Management annually, before the AGM of Pistol Australia Inc.

**2.14** Any other such matters or things as are conducive to or incidental to the NCC objectives.

**3. Meetings:**

The business of the NCC will be conducted at an Annual Meeting and such other meetings as required:

**3.01** At any meeting of the NCC, the Director shall be Chairman. In his absence, a Chairman may be elected from those present;

**3.02** Business at any NCC meeting may be decided by a simple majority vote, the Chairman shall have an additional casting vote;

**3.03** All business at any NCC meeting shall be minuted and copies circulated within 21 days to the NCC and to the PA Secretary;

**3.04** No meeting of the NCC shall occur unless a majority of elected members are present.

**4. Miscellaneous:**

Amendment to these Regulations will be by way of recommendation to PA Management Committee.
