2011 PA NATIONAL JUNIOR CAMP

The 2011 PA Junior Camp will be held 1 - 9 July at the Belmont Shooting Complex in Brisbane. The camp is designed to provide advanced training for young shooters to develop their technical skills as well as their mental and physical fitness. The aim is to improve their performance at all levels of competition and achieve their short, intermediate and long term goals. Specific objectives of the camp include to:

- Develop fundamental shooting techniques;
- Analyse performance and identify strategies for improvement;
- Establish, refine and focus on short, intermediate and long term goals;
- Instil motivation to achieve the individual athlete's potential, and
- Promote the value of team spirit for the benefit of the team and the individual.

Participants in the 2011 PA Junior Camp will compete in the intra-camp competition(s) and also have the opportunity to compete in the 2011 Australia Games.

CAMP ATTENDEES

PA will fund a total of sixteen (16) juniors, two from each State/Territory, to attend the PA Junior Camp, which is open to all junior PA members as nominated by their respective States/Territory Association on or before 11 April 2011. In the event that any State/Territory Association nominates only one junior or does not nominate any juniors from their respective State/Territory, PA will liaise with the other State/Territory Associations who wish to nominate additional juniors to fill such vacancies and be funded by PA to attend the camp.

If, after PA has received and approved all sixteen (16) PA funded nominations, the State/Territory Associations may nominate additional juniors who wish to attend the Camp, however, this will be at the expense of the individual or the State/Territory Association.

FIREARMS

Transport of firearms to and from the Camp is the responsibility of the respective State/Territory Association and in that responsibility must familiarise themselves with the firearms transport policy of the relevant airlines. At the very least these airlines require that firearms are checked in at the point of departure by a PA member and/or adult holding a valid firearms licence.

On arrival at Brisbane airport, firearms will be collected by a PA member with a valid firearms licence.

COACHING STAFF

Peter Heuke and Noel Ryan will each act in the position of Senior Coach and will be assisted by other PA coaches selected on the basis of their coaching performance, knowledge and experience.

CODE OF CONDUCT

As a prerequisite, juniors attending the Camp must read, sign, date and return the attached PA Code of Conduct to PA prior to the camp commencement date. As a matter of due diligence, it is expected that all coaches attending the camp (including personal coaches) will also read and familiarise themselves with the requirements of the PA Code of Conduct.
